Curriculum Specialist Report

Curriculum Specialist provided an update on the curriculum remaining for Fall 2022 and informed the committee that we have 141 courses and 37 programs remaining.

Articulation Officer Report

Articulation Officer shared with committee that Assembly Bill 928, which requires CSUs and UCs systems to streamline lower division general education patterns, and Assembly Bill 1111, which requires all community colleges to adopt a common course numbering system, was signed last week.

Division Reports: All division reps

Science/Engineering/Math: Rep asked committee members how they bring up new curriculum to their division. Career Technical Education: Rep shared that they don't discuss it as a division but rather as a department. Social Science: Rep shared with committee that they don't discuss it as a division but rather as a department. Rep also shared that next week they will discuss FSA and Global Studies prefix.

Language Arts: Rep shared that they are working on the out of compliance courses. Rep also shared that they don't discus curriculum as a division but rather as a department.

Health Science: Rep shared that new curriculum is discussed in department but not as a division. Rep is still working on out of compliance courses.

Counseling: Rep shared that they discuss curriculum as a division after courses have gone through the curriculum approval process.

Business: Rep shared that they don't discuss new curriculum as a department or division.

Kinesiology: Rep shared that she has curriculum as a standing item in the agenda in their division meetings.

Library: No report.

Fine Arts: Rep shared that most of the THEA courses are complete and will be working with faculty. He also shared that new curriculum is not shared in their division.

CPL Coordinator Report: Jolena Grande

Not present.

Administration Report

Interim VPI shared with committee that 48% of students wanted in-person instruction and 49% of student wanted fully online courses. For the Spring 2022 schedule, 54% of our course sections will be in-person. In addition, only 22% of staff and faculty have met the vaccine mandate. She asked reps to encourage colleagues and students to upload their vaccine information. Curriculum reps shared their concerns with continuing teaching online. She also shared that Fullerton is collecting higher apportionment for non-credit courses and she is working with Joyce and Treisa to look at ENGL NO1 C so they can start collecting apportionment.

Chair Report

Meetings-Chair is attending Curriculum regional meeting next week and Plenary in November.

West Ed project-Department binders will be presented at each department before Christmas.

Curriculum reviews-Chair shared that she posted on Canvas level reports.

A.S. Representative asked committee why some courses are only offered once a year. Interim VPI shared that, sometimes, due to low enrollment, courses get cancelled. She also shared that course substitutions can be offer to students if they need a course to complete program. A.S. representative also asked if more students can participate in the curriculum meetings and Chair communicated that curriculum meetings are open to public.

Other-any additional concerns committee members might want to bring up for items that do not require vote Social Science rep shared with committee that he researched Fullerton curriculum on Sign Language and it's housed in the Disability Studies department. He suggested if we were to bring back Sign Language courses they could be housed in the counseling division, under DSST prefix.
