4	<p>Technology Updates and progress report on campus network project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Digital ID application can now be viewed in Sandbox. The Digital ID profile includes: credentials, QR code and photo. A barcode option will become available for older scanning devices. This mechanism will be used to access labs, meeting spaces, etc. The information is pulled through the Banner server. Important to build in the backend, including communication with SARS. Developers are working on photo stream encryption for security purposes. This Digital ID will be useful for Students, Staff and Faculty. - Network refresh will include new phone trees and campus architecture. In Spring, Technology Services will host new phone demos to include three different CISCO phone models. The new system will include voicemail to email capability, roaming services and an active directory. - Wireless density testing is underway. A full campus walkthrough will take place to verify 100% coverage; zero signal drop off. The number of hotspots will be triple. - The layer 1 new fiber optics project will begin after the New Year. Work will be conducted in the evening to refrain from campus disruptions. - The initial firewall project has concluded, the second firewall installation will be issued in February. This has become a District wide project. - Michael Land has been busy at work rolling out new copiers to departments across campus. The new copier login system is a slight change to process and culture. The team hopes to understand and analyze consumption and usage. We continue to fix bugs and outsource support for maintenance issues. - The Cypress Connect App received commendations through Modo Labs as one of the “Most Innovative Campus Apps of 2019”. A big congratulations to all who have been instrumental in the success of the app. The Cypress Experience will continue to improve and evolve with this app, including the implementation of augmented reality. Developers are working with augmented reality to first identify buildings and their internal directories. This technology will further enhance the teaching and learning experience as it evolves.
